

Be on the Lookout for Spills and Illicit Discharges

Clay Township's Public Works Department is responsible to keep our roads in shape and our Township parks looking good. Additionally, our Public Works Department is responsible for maintaining the public storm sewer system that handles the stormwater that drains from the roads. This system of pipes and roadside swales typically discharges water into waterways like Middle Creek, Seglock Run, Indian Run and other smaller tributaries; making it important to keep spills and illicit discharges out of the stormwater.

Clay Township's Public Works Department needs your help with reporting any unusual flows through the stormwater system that you may notice. Examples are odd colored water, strong smell in the water or an oily sheen could be a sign of an accidental spill or possibly an ongoing pollution issue.
